- Actively participating in preparation of projects and continuously pursuing the concerned agencies to get it sanctioned under the guidance of Professors/ senior faculty members and HOD's.
- Should conduct at least one seminar/ workshop in each semester.
- Spend considerable part of the time research activities. Be a guide for at least 2 M.Tech and 4 B.Tech students in addition to guiding Ph.D students. Enhance the R &D and institutional consultancy activities with industry.
- Publish at least 2 technical papers in reputed conferences/ Journals in each semester. Provide guidance and assistance to the faculty members under your mentorship to publish at least one technical paper.
- Prepare and send technical projects proposal to AICTE/DST CSI etc., and lead the projects.
- Collaborate with Industry for applicable research and product development. Enter into MOUs with Industry/ Govt. organization/ University which encourage R & D.

Training and Placements:

- All the departments need to coordinate with the Training cell and Placement division for coordinating training and placement activities.

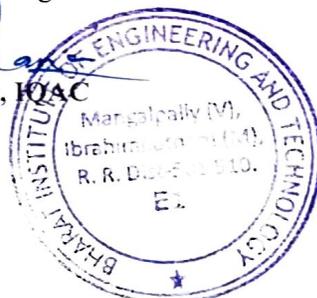

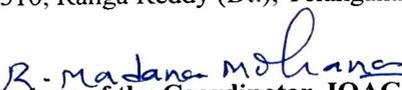
